
The Assessment Battery for Communication in Romanian language: A pilot study to get started

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Abstract

Pragmatics plays a fundamental role in daily communicative interactions, and accurate assessment could be important in both developmental and clinical settings. This study presents the first data on a preliminary translation and adaptation of the Assessment Battery for Communication (ABaCo) into Romanian. The ABaCo was developed to assess a wide range of phenomena in both comprehension and production, and has already shown to be effective and psychometrically sound in the Italian context. Instrument translation and adaptation is a delicate but important process to enable progress in a cross-cultural perspective.
